Can I use my child's NDIS plan to fund Parent Training?

The answer is most likely YES!

The NDIS recognises the importance of training and has a specific line item for it.

It's called Carer/Parent Training (pg 92 of the pricing arrangements). It comes under 'Other Supports' but bills to your Capacity Building - Improved Daily Living (therapy) budget.

Carer/Parent Training does not need to be itemised in your child's plan.

You also don't need an Autism diagnosis.

Most planners don't think to specifically include it in your child's plan. It's your Choice and Control if you choose to access parent training.

NDIS eligibility always refers to these 3 criteria;

Reasonable & Necessary
